

Born as an immediate response to help citizens affected by blast

Rebirth Beirut was established on September 21, 2020 in response to the tragic blast that struck the city of Beirut on August 4, 2020.

More than 200 people lost their lives, thousands were injured and hundreds of thousands were left homeless, with massive damage to businesses and shoos.

The level of destruction and suffering experienced in Beirut due to the blast was apocalyptic, coupled with the financial crisis and COVID-19 pandemic. This led to a major flight of skilled youth looking for opportunities abroad.


