



WHO ARE



A Charitable Dental Relief Organization established in 2010 that "has focused on making dental care accessible to vulnerable populations deprived of it, and more broadly, promoting oral hygiene education and practice."

What do they do?

- Connect Volunteer Dentists and Oral Welfare experts to under privileged community members.
- Provide awareness on oral well-fare, treatments and Dental-Kit support.

WHY HAVE WE STARTED IN LEBANON?

The economic crisis witnessed:

- Inflation of food prices by 332%
- Minimum wage capped at
 675,000 LBP (=\$22.5)
- The price of 20 liters of fuel = Minimum wage.

Due to these factors, dental care and hygiene are becoming a *luxury* to a big portion of residents of Lebanon.



WHY HAVE WE STARTED IN LEBANON?

MINIMUM OFFICIAL WAGE: 600K-700K LBP

MINIMAL COST OF A FILLING: >500K LBP

ONE TOOTHPASTE: 150K-300K LBP

ONE TOOTHBRUSH: 80K-150K LBP



WHY IS THIS IMPORTANT?

- Caries are **permanently damaged areas** in the hard surface of your teeth that develop into tiny openings or holes.
- Caries are among the world's most common health problems. Anyone who has teeth can get caries, including infants.
- If caries aren't treated, they get larger and affect deeper layers of your teeth. They can lead to a **severe toothache**, **infection** and tooth loss.

WHY IS THIS IMPORTANT?



- Periodontal disease: Two Types (Gum Inflammation More Common; Inflammation of the Gum and the Bones)
- Periodontal disease can lead to further complications including heart complications, strokes, diabetes, and respiratory issues.
- If proper treatment is not applied to children at an early age it can lead to issues with digestion and speech problems.

DENTAL SERVICES THAT ROTA-TEETH WILL PROVIDE



Oral Hygiene Kits and Awareness

Kids will be provided with a new toothbrush and toothpaste every 6 months.



Composite Fillings

Decayed teeth will be cleaned then filled with composite to restore their function.



Extraction and Root Canals

Emergency treatments will be performed on painful and very damaged teeth.



Cleaning and Prevention

Regular cleanings and fluoride application will help prevent and stop cavities.

Oral health and dental outreach is a universal matter.

With Dental Mavericks, we are aiming to provide dental care for 160 underprivileged children residing in Lebanon.
